Procedure #5120 Residence

DETERMINING RESIDENCE

Residency for tuition purposes is determined at the time of admission or readmission to Chemeketa Community College.

“Permanent Residence” is defined as a person’s home, to which one intends to return after any absence and in which one’s dependents reside for an unlimited period of time.¹

Resident Tuition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students with a permanent residence in Oregon, California, Idaho, Nevada, or Washington for 90 days prior to the start of the term ● Military and Veteran students and dependents who qualify for resident tuition under federal or state law such as ORS 350.290 or Section 702 of the Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014* ● Native American and Alaskan Native Oregon High School Graduates ** ● Citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Republic of Palau **
Non-Resident Tuition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students with a permanent residence in a state that does not border Oregon ● International students

CHANGING RESIDENCE

Changes to residency status may be requested for up to one term prior to the current term, the current time, or future terms only. To apply for a change in residency status for tuition purposes, students should follow these steps:

1. Complete an Application to Change Residency form, available on the Chemeketa public website.
2. Provide at least one document that includes: a date to show physical presence and intent to reside in Oregon, California, Idaho, Nevada, or Washington; the name of the student

printed on the documents; and a physical address in Oregon or a border state.¹ Please see the Application to Change Residency form for examples of acceptable documentation.

3. If a student changes residency to out of state they will no longer be considered residents of Oregon or a border state and out-of-state tuition fees would apply.
